Fitzpatrick exhibition opens in New York

Irish artist Roisin Fitzpatrick's Artist of the Light exhibition is now on display at the Consulate General of Ireland, New York. By Shelley Marsden - 01/11/11



The exhibition was officially opened by American Ireland Fund chair Loretta Brennan Glucksman and Consul General Noel Kilkenny.

Other dignitaries included Ambassador Jean Kennedy Smith, Riverdance composer Bill Whelan, "Galway Bay" author Mary Pat Kelly and Irish fashion designer and creative

director of Theia, Don O'Neill.

Fitzpatrick used the near-death experience of a brain aneurysm as inspiration for a series of modern artworks which became the Artist of the Light collection. The exhibition is open to the public by appointment Monday to Friday from 10 am to 3 pm until November 30, at 345 Park Avenue at 51 Street, New York.
