Exhibition of Roisin Fitzpatrick – Artist of the Light®

Roisin Fitzpatrick – Artist of the Light, is a leading contemporary Irish artist. With over ten exhibitions on both sides of the Atlantic over the past decade, including an artwork on permanent display at the National Concert Hall in Dublin and the Irish American Heritage Museum in New York, her work has received great critical acclaim. Roisin is also the author of the best-selling book "Taking Heaven Lightly".

Following a brain haemorrhage and near-death experience in her mid-thirties, Róisín Fitzpatrick turned this adversity into a positive life change. Integrating her passion for sharing the beauty of the eternal light, with her business skills from her former professional career at the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, United Nations and European Commission, she has become an internationally successful artist. Passionate about sharing the beauty of the light from her near-death experience, in a way that people can connect with their own inner light, she was inspired to create a series of artworks – the *Artist of the Light* collection. Many of the designs originate from the ancient megalithic art of her Irish heritage.

Róisín's primary intention through this art is to enhance well-being in both residential and corporate environments. Roisin's art has been endorsed by New York Times best-selling authors Deepak Chopra and Marianne Williamson and also Roma Downey, actor from Touched by an Angel. Her art has been critically acclaimed by Forbes, Wall Street Journal, Washington Post, Boston Globe, Artnews, IN New York, WHERE New York, Irish Arts Review, the Irish Times, Irish Independent, Irish America Magazine, Irish Examiner USA, Irish Echo and Irish Voice New York.

Roisin's art provided the stage setting for the Conscious Capitalism Conference at Bentley University in May 2011 & 2012, and The European Year of Culture Conference at Dublin Castle in 2018. She was also a guest speaker at those events. In addition, she has been a guest speaker at the United Nations SRC Enlightenment Society, the Irish International Business Network and the Irish Business Organization in New York. The Irish Arts Review described her work as 'Illuminating New York.'

Giving Back

"Over the past few years, one of my greatest joys has been to donate artwork to raise funds for various charities. I have intentionally focused on charities that strive to improve the quality of life for people of all ages by providing hope and inspiration, especially during the most challenging of times." Roisin regularly donates art to raise funds for many different charities. To date, the art has raised funds for the American Ireland Fund's Barretstown children's camp, Laura Lynn and Jack & Jill projects, Haven (for building homes in Haiti), The Irish Arts Center in New York and for breast cancer awareness, The Rotunda Hospital and The Irish Hospice Foundation.

More recently, Roisin has filmed for the first time in 4K the solar alignment of the Winter Solstice at Newgrange, Ireland, which dates back over 5,000 years. This filming is part of a wider filming and visual arts project that she is undertaking to bring the wisdom of ancient Irish heritage to light and to life.
